2. Is the violator **free** of convictions for any sex crime as defined by L.R.S. 14:2(13)?
3. Is the violator **free** of convictions for any crimes of violence as defined in L.R.S. 14:2(13)?
4. Is the violator **free** of any pending felony charge(s), felony warrant(s), or felony detainer(s)?
5. Is the probationer **free** of any felony convictions during the present period of supervision?
6. Is the violator **free** of any technical violation of absconding to another state from which he has been returned to this state and which is one of their current technical violations?
7. Does the violator have a minimum of six months remaining on supervision at the time of his expected entry into this program?
8. The violator has not exhibited a history of habitual or compulsive use of violence against the person.
9. Is the violator, absent his participation and successful completion of this program, likely to be revoked for their current technical violations? (Does not apply to Act 402 cases.)
10. Does the supervising officer and supervisor recommend this violator's placement in this program?
11. Does the violator volunteer to participate in this program?
